¹ The number of transfer credits granted for each course depends on the issuing college's definition of its credit system. Credits from a school that operates on a semester credit system transfer one-to-one. Credits from schools on a quarter credit system will transfer at a ratio of .67 semester credit for each quarter credit on a course-by-course basis, rounded to the nearest whole credit. For example, a course for which the student earned three quarter credits will transfer to ACHS as two semester credits; a course with four quarter credits would transfer as three semester credits. Courses completed on a clock hour system will transfer at the rate of 45-clock hours equals one semester credit.
